



# Classroom Supply List for 2019-2020

## THIRD GRADE

---

- 1 folder with pockets
- 3 glue sticks
- 2 packs of pencils [Ticonderoga preferred but not necessary]
- \$5 for extra supplies [We'll buy dividers for the binder, pencil pockets, and oil pastels in bulk]
- Composition notebook
- 3 fine tip black sharpies
- 1 box of colored pencils [We have packs of crayons]
- 3 red pens
- 1 box of tissue
- 1 container of Clorox type disinfecting wipes
- 1 hand sanitizer bottle
- 1 Elmer's glue bottle
- [optional] Markers
- A **New International Version (NIV) Bible**, preferably one with a concordance. There is a resource in the back of some youth Bibles called a "dictionary concordance" which is more confusing and less thorough. If you can find one with a regular concordance, that would be best. This Bible should be one that can be left at school. Any NIV thinline reference Bible would work great. You can get one at [www.CBD.com](http://www.CBD.com). This is the same Bible for 3rd – 5th grade.
- A **1 inch three ring binder**. Just FYI, the ones that we've found work the best are 1½ inch Avery Heavy-Duty (or Durable) View binders with EZ-turn rings. You don't have to get that exact binder but the one you buy does need some very specific things. It needs to have **pockets inside the front and back covers**. It also needs to have a **clear plastic over the outside front and back covers** into which a paper can be slid (usually called a "view" binder). Please really check to see that all these features are present. Just bring it in empty on the first day and we will set it up together.
