- 1 folder with pockets
- 2 glue sticks and 1 small bottle of glue
- 2 packs of pencils [Ticonderoga preferred but not required]
- \$5 for extra supplies [we buy dividers for the binder, pencil pockets, and oil pastels in bulk]
- 1 composition notebook
- 3 fine tip black sharpies
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 box of tissue
- 1 pack skinny dry erase markers [for student's white boards]
- Markers (optional)
- 1 container of Clorox wipes
- 1 reusable water bottle with straw type open and close for fewer spills [this will stay in our class]
- A New International Version (NIV) Bible, with a concordance
- A 1-inch three-ring binder. Just FYI, the ones that we've found work the best are 1 ½ inch Avery Heavy-Duty (or Durable) View binders with EZ-turn rings. You don't have to get that exact binder but the one you buy does need some very specific things:
 - It needs to have pockets inside the front and back covers.
 - It needs to have a clear plastic over the outside front and back covers into which a paper can be slid (usually called a 'view' binder).
 - Please check to see if all these features are present.
 - Bring empty on the first day of school and we will set it up together.
