- 1. **Treasurer's Report** – Maggie Torres
 - **Expenses:**
 - Teacher Appreciation: \$542.67
 - Drive for Schools deposit: \$3030
 - **Current Account Balance:** \$27,601.73
- 2. **Drive for Schools Update** – Pam Hanson
 - **Amount Raised So Far:** \$5000
 - This is significantly lower than the usual \$16,000 at this point.
