



## FOURTH GRADE

- 1 set of (12-24) colored pencils
- 1 set of thin markers
- 1 highlighter set (pink, yellow, green, blue)
- 1 basic calculator
- \$5 extra for extra supplies for inside binder (we will purchase in bulk)
- 1 backpack (not rolling kind, they do not fit in cubbies)
- 2 wide-ruled one subject spiral notebook (two different colors)
- 2 packages (or boxes) of standard pre-sharpened #2 pencils
- Several blue pens
- 2 pencil pouches (1 for art supplies, 1 for everyday)
- 1 or 2 dry erase markers
- 1 random mismatched sock from home that could be used as a whiteboard eraser
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 small or 1 large Elmer's glue stick (s)
- 1 package of wide ruled paper
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 container of Clorox wipes
- A New International Version (NIV) Bible, preferably with a concordance. This Bible should be one that can be left at school. If you have trouble finding one, go to [www.cbd.com](http://www.cbd.com) and type in "NIV Bible concordance thinline." Your third grade Bible should be fine.
- A 1 ½ inch three-ring binder. The ones that we've found work the best are 1 ½ Avery Heavy-Duty (or Durable) View binders with EZ-turn rings. You don't have to get that exact binder but the one you buy does need some very specific things:
  - Needs to have pockets inside the front and back covers
  - Needs to have a place where a paper can be slid into the outside front and back covers (usually called "view" binder)
  - Double check to see all these features are present
  - Bring the binder empty the first day and we will set it up together
